

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy applies to the website www.skorpionrope.com operated by SKorpion Rope and its affiliates (“SKorpion Rope”, “We”, “Our”, and “Use”), and to the processing of personal information by SKorpion Rope as contemplated in this privacy policy.

Any reference to “you” or “your” means you, the user of this web site and/or our Services, and/or purchaser of our Goods.

This Policy sets out the procedures that We follow when dealing with your personal data.

We are committed not only to the letter of the law but also to the spirit of the law and place a high premium on the correct, lawful and fair handling of all personal data, respecting the legal rights, privacy and trust of all individuals with whom we deal.

This Policy aims to ensure compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Under the GDPR, we must process your Personal Data in accordance with the following principles:

- Processed lawfully, fairly, and transparently
- Collected only for specific legitimate purposes
- Adequate, relevant, and limited to what is necessary
- Must be accurate and kept up to date
- Stored only as long as is necessary
- Ensure appropriate security, integrity and confidentiality

How we obtain personal information about you.

When you place an order for Goods with us, we may collect the follow information (which is given to us by you):

- Your name
- Your postal address
- Your telephone number
- Your email address

We will use this information in order to contact you about and provide you with the Goods that you have ordered from us.

If you give us explicit permission to, by opting in, We will also use this information in order to send you newsletters or other updates about our Goods or Services that we think you may be interested in.

Any personal data We have about you will be stored securely against unauthorised processing, and against accidental loss, destruction or damage.

Should We suffer or suspect that there has been a breach of your data, We will report such a breach to the Data Protection Authority within 72 hours. We will also tell you if there has been, or if We suspect there may have been, a high risk to your rights and freedoms (such as identity theft or personal safety).

Retention of Data

We will retain your data in order to process any Orders you place with us, and for as long as we feel Our Goods or Services may be of interest to you (unless you request that we delete your personal data).

How we collect and use non-personal information

Please note that when anyone visits any part of Our web site, we automatically collect certain non-personal information such as the type of computer operating system and browser being used, and the domain name of the internet service provider. We sometimes use the non-personal information that we collect to improve the design and content of the site and to enable us to personalise your experience.

We may also track the effectiveness of any email marketing campaigns. Tracked activity may include: the opening of emails, forwarding of emails, and clicking of any links within the content of the emails. This information is used to refine future email campaigns and supply you with more relevant content.

Social Media Platforms

Communication, engagement and actions taken through external social media platforms that this website and its owners participate on are custom to the terms and conditions as well as the privacy policies held with each social media platform respectively.

Users are advised to use social media platforms wisely and communicate / engage upon them with due care and caution in regard to their own privacy and personal details. All such parties will be required to keep your personal data secure and only process it in accordance with our instructions. We may also disclose your personal information if, in our opinion, disclosure is required by law.

Cookies and tracking software

We may use "cookies" and other types of tracking software in order to personalise your visit to our website and enhance your experience by gaining a better understanding of your particular interests and customising our pages for you. A cookie is a message given to a web browser by a web server and which is then stored by the browser in a text file. Each time the browser requests a page from the server this message is sent back which enables the user's computer to be identified. We may use the information provided by cookies to analyse trends, administer the website, or for research and marketing purposes to help us better serve you. No information which personally identifies you will be collected through the cookies. You can set your browser to notify you before you receive a cookie so you have the chance to accept it and you can also set your browser to turn off all cookies.
